

## 3GN SA

Requirements for Clubs, membership types, matches and DSS points.

### CLUB REQUIREMENTS.

All clubs wanting to host 3 Gun Nation matches have to meet the following requirements:

1. Register as a club on the 3GN website

Cost is \$50 per annum.
2. Host minimum of 6 classifiers per year ( 1 January – 31 December)

3. Publish match details on 3GN website regarding stages and classifier details.
4. Appoint a club representative/administrator to do the scoring & uploading of results.
5. Classifier results to be uploaded @ \$3 per classifier on the 3GN website by the club administrator.
6. Club to have a minimum of three (3) 3GN members. Membership is \$45 per annum. The three 3GN members must have their 6 classifier results uploaded for the year in order for the club to maintain its 3GN Club Series status.
7. Register club on the 3GN SA website. No registration fee.
8. Each Club Series Match must have a minimum of 1 classifier for 3GN SA members to :
  - a. Be on the 3GN SA national log.
  - b. Results to be used for database for DSS points.
9. Club administrator to email results to 3GN SA.

### TYPES OF MEMBERSHIP

#### A. 3GN SA MEMBERSHIP

1. Register as a member on the 3GN SA website (link to go here) Cost is R250 per annum. Membership period to align with SAPSA (1 April – 30 March )

#### B. 3GN SA / SAPSA MEMBERSHIP.

1. Register as a member on the 3GN SA website (link to go here) Cost is R250 per annum. Membership period to align with SAPSA (1 April – 30 March )
2. Register as a member of SAPSA. (procedure to follow) Cost as determined by SAPSA annual council meeting.
3. Shoot the minimum of 6 points to earn DSS, as per SAPSA requirements.

### BENEFITS OF 3GN SA MEMBERSHIP.

1. Classifier results uploaded to a SA Leader board. So you can compare your results to all 3GN shooters in SA.

2. Top 16 in each division (Unlimited, Practical, Factory, Heavy Sport & Heavy Optics) on the SA Leader board get an invite to 3GN SA Shoot Off Championship held around November of the year. (minimum number of competitors per division is 20)
3. SA Leader board winners in each division wins prizes.
4. Each 3GN match shot in the year earns you 1 ticket into a 3GN SA National Draw for a Firearm/s held at the end of the year.
5. Only 3GN SA members are eligible to shoot Regionals and SA Championship matches (level 2-3).
6. Opportunity to be crowned SA Division Champion at SA Championship match.
7. Being a SAPSA member as well, will earn you :
  - a. DSS points for shooting all types of 3GN matches (level 1-3) as well as IPSC club matches (level 1)
  - b. Endorsements for Firearms suitable for IPSC/3GN.
  - c. With an additional Provincial fee allow you to shoot IPSC level 2-5 matches.

**C. 3GN /3GN SA/SAPSA MEMBERSHIP.**

- 1 Register as a member on the 3GN SA website (link to go here) Cost is R250 per annum. Membership period to align with SAPSA (1 April – 30 March )
2. Register as a member of SAPSA. (procedure to follow) Cost as determined by SAPSA annual council meeting.
3. Register as a competing member on the 3GN website.

Cost is \$45 per annum.
4. Shoot 4 classifiers, that are uploaded to 3GN, to get a ranking and to compete to be eligible for points towards qualification.

**BENEFITS OF 3GN/3GN SA/SAPSA MEMBERSHIP.**

1. Classifier results uploaded to International Leader board. So you can compare your scores internationally. [http://3gunnation.com/club\\_series](http://3gunnation.com/club_series) (go to club series shooters/3GN members)
2. Club champions and 3GN Division leaders receive an invite to 3GN Nationals in the USA, in October of each year.
3. To be able to earn National colours.
4. Members are eligible for prizes from 3GN Sponsors via annual competitions and social media competitions.
5. Each 3GN match shot in the year earns you 2 tickets, instead of 1, into a 3GN SA National Draw for a Firearm/s held at the end of the year.

**TYPES/LEVELS OF MATCHES**

**A. CLUB SERIES MATCH (LEVEL 1)**

1. Minimum 4 stages.
2. Minimum of 1 classifier.
3. Minimum of 40 rounds of each firearm – rifle, shotgun & handgun.
4. 3GN club rules to be used.

**B. REGIONAL MATCH (LEVEL 2)**

1. Minimum of 8 stages.
2. Minimum of 1 classifier.
3. Minimum of 100 rounds of each firearm – rifle, shotgun & handgun.
4. 3GN Regional rules to be used.

**C. SA SHOOT OFF CHAMPIONSHIP (LEVEL 2) – ONLY 1 MATCH PER YEAR.**

1. Invitation only.
2. Division shoot off only.
3. J ladder as per rankings on SA Leader board.
4. Shoot off CoF is 6 Rifle, 6 shotgun & 7 Handgun.
5. 3GN Regional rules to be used.

**D. SA CHAMPIONSHIP (LEVEL 3) - ONLY 1 MATCH PER YEAR.**

1. Minimum of 10 stages.
2. Minimum of 2 classifiers.
3. Minimum of 140 rounds of each firearm – rifle, shotgun & handgun.
4. 3GN Regional rules to be used.

**DSS POINTS AS PER SAPSA REQUIREMENTS :**

- a. Level 1 match earns 1 DSS point.
- b. Level 2 match earns 2 DSS points.
- c. Level 3 match earns 3 DSS points.
